### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The course is organized as a theoretical-practical review of relevant aspects of breast pathology with cytologic and histologic correlation. The course is designed to be very interactive. The faculty will give lectures, show typical morphologic entities and discuss how to approach specific issues and multiheaded microscopes (Two 16 headed microscopes and 2 microscopes with projected screens), dividing the attendants into 4 different groups. The attendants will rotate through all the different settings, so everyone has similar exposure to the invited faculty, cases and settings.

The course is limited to 75 individuals in order to accommodate everybody at the practical sessions. An option to attend the lectures only is also available with a lower registration fee and limited to 125 individuals plus.
